




Giving this holiday season is an act of direct, lasting and meaningful support to our immigrant neighbors in the tradition of *dar posada* and welcomes them to Arkansas.



English and Skills

English and Life Skills classes teach relevant language and life skills for the whole family, helping immigrants connect and integrate with their communities.

Financial Empowerment
